1 Samuel 21 January 27, 2019

1 Samuel 21 (ESV): "Then David came to Nob, to Ahimelech the priest. And Ahimelech came to meet David, trembling, and said to him, 'Why are you alone, and no one with you?' 2 And David said to Ahimelech the priest, 'the king has charged me with a matter and said to me, "Let no one know anything of the matter about which I send you, and with which I have charged you." I have made an appointment with the young men for such and such a place "

"...3 Now then, what do you have on hand? Give me five loaves of bread, or whatever is here.' 4 And the priest answered David, 'I have no common bread on hand, but there is holy bread - if the young men have kept themselves from women.' 5 And David answered the priest, 'Truly women have been kept from us as always when I go on an expedition. The vessels of the young men are holy even when it is an ordinary journey. How much more today will their vessels be holy?'..."

"...6 So the priest gave him the holy bread, for there was no bread there but the bread of the Presence, which is removed from before the LORD, to be replaced by hot bread on the day it is taken away. 7 Now a certain man of the servants of Saul was there that day, detained before the LORD. His name was Doeg the Edomite, the chief of Saul's herdsmen...."

"...8 Then David said to Ahimelech, 'Then have you not here a spear or a sword at hand? For I have brought neither my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's business required haste.' 9 And the priest said, 'The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom you struck down in the Valley of Elah, behold, it is here wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod. If you will take that, take it, for there is none but that here.' And David said, 'There is none like that; give it to me.'..."

"...10 And David rose and fled that day from Saul and went to Achish the king of Gath. 11 And the servants of Achish said to him, 'Is not this David the king of the land? Did they not sing to one another of him in dances, "Saul has struck down his thousands, and David his ten thousands"?' 12 And David took these words to heart and was much afraid of Achish the king of Gath...."



"...13 So he changed his behavior before them and pretended to be insane in their hands and made marks on the doors of the gate and let his spittle run down his beard. 14 Then Achish said to his servants, 'Behold, you see the man is mad. Why then have you brought him to me? 15 Do I lack madmen, that you have brought this fellow to behave as a madman in my presence? Shall this fellow come into my house?"

Matthew 12:1-8 (NIV): "At that time Jesus went through the grain fields on the Sabbath. His disciples were hungry and began to pick some heads of grain and eat them. 2 When the Pharisees saw this, they said to him, 'Look! Your disciples are doing what is unlawful on the Sabbath.' 3 He answered, 'Haven't you read what David did when he and his companions were hungry? 4 He entered the house of God, and he and his companions ate the consecrated bread - which was not lawful for them to do, but only for the priests....

"...5 Or haven't you read in the Law that the priests on Sabbath duty in the temple desecrate the Sabbath and yet are innocent? 6 I tell you that something greater than the temple is here. 7 If you had known what these words mean, "I desire mercy, not sacrifice," you would not have condemned the innocent. 8 For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

Deuteronomy 23:24-25 (ESV): "If you go into your neighbor's vineyard, you may eat your fill of grapes, as many as you wish, but you shall not put any in your bag. 25 If you go into your neighbor's standing grain, you may pluck the ears with your hand, but you shall not put a sickle to your neighbor's standing grain."

Exodus 34:21 (NIV): "Six days you shall labor, but on the seventh day you shall rest; even during the plowing season and harvest you must rest."
