
A SUMMER STROLL THROUGH THE BOOK OF ACTS

Acts 6:9-12 (ESV): "Then some of those who belonged to the synagogue of the Freedmen (as it was called), and of the Cyrenians, and of the Alexandrians, and of those from Cilicia and Asia, rose up and disputed with Stephen. 10 But they could not withstand the wisdom and the Spirit with which he was speaking. 11 Then they secretly instigated men who said, 'We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses and God.' 12 And they stirred up the people and the elders and the scribes, and they came upon him and seized him and brought him before the council."

Acts 7:51-53 (ESV): "You stiff-necked people, uncircumcised in heart and ears, you always resist the Holy Spirit. As your fathers did, so do you. 52 Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who announced beforehand the coming of the Righteous One, whom you have now betrayed and murdered, 53 you who received the law as delivered by angels and did not keep it."

Acts 7:57-60 (ESV): "They cried out with a loud voice and stopped their ears and rushed together at him. 58 Then they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul. 59 And as they were stoning Stephen, he called out, 'Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.' 60 And falling to his knees he cried out with a loud voice, 'Lord, do not hold this sin against them.' And when he had said this, he fell asleep."


Luke 23:34 (ESV): "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."



Main Point THE MORE YOU HAVE TO FORCE YOUR ARGUMENT, THE LESS FORCE YOUR ARGUMENT HAS.





"[Prosecutor Wes] Nance said the four were in the front yard when an argument started between Turner and his girlfriend's son about if Chevy or Ford is a better car manufacturer. Acts 4:32-32 (ESV): "Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common. 33 And with great power the apostles were giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all. 34 There was not a needy person among them, for as many as were owners of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of what was sold 35 and laid it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to each as any had need."


