






Mark 3:13-19 (ESV): "And he went up on the mountain and called to him those whom he desired, and they came to him. 14 And he appointed twelve (whom he also named apostles) so that they might be with him and he might send them out to preach 15 and have authority to cast out demons. 16 He appointed the twelve: Simon (to whom he gave the name Peter); 17 James the son of Zebedee and John the brother of James (to whom he gave the name Boanerges, that is, Sons of Thunder); 18 Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Zealot, 19 and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him."




MAIN POINT



THE ONLY THING THE DISCIPLES HAD IN COMMON WAS BEING COMMON.

Acts 4:13 (ESV): "Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated, common men, they were astonished. And they recognized that they had been with Jesus."



Mark 15:40 (ESV): "There were also women looking on from a distance, among whom were Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James the younger and of Joses, and Salome."


Matthew 10:3 (ESV): "...Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus..."

Luke 6:15 (ESV): "...and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon who was called the Zealot..."

Acts 1:13 (ESV): "And when they had entered, they went up to the upper room, where they were staying, Peter and John and James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot and Judas the son of James."

Matthew 26:20 (ESV): "When it was evening, he reclined at table with the twelve."




James 4:14 (ESV): "What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes."



John 8:54 (ESV): "Jesus answered, 'If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father who glorifies me.'"


