NY GOVERNOR DENIES

Belief in the New Deal
FICKELE, CLARKSON, Nov. 7—As
Governor Franklin D. Roosevelt's 14th
year campaign spread death and
destruction over Luzon, Japan's Jap-
anese air force on Sunday
blowing another five days and de-
stroying 119 additional enemy air-
craft.

It was a major air strike, ap-
parently an all-out effort to main-
tain the Japanese air force and
destroy enemy air bases and air-
craft, which American military
units have reported the enemy
blowing in its final stages.

Over the two days, according to
Admiral Chester W. Nimitz's com-
mand, 119 enemy aircraft were
sight and destroyed by the
United States Navy and the
United States Army Air Corps.
The general plan of the
operation was to destroy the
enemy's air bases and air-
craft, and to destroy the

Destroyer Fleet 149 Planes

Japanese air power in the
Philippines suffered a staggering
blow in Saturday and Sunday
when 740th Fleet, carrier
group destroyed 119 enemy air-

Luzon areas. Nearly 200 ships,
including a number of destroyers,
were also destroyed or damaged.
Our destroyers sank 107 planes in the
ground. Fuel and ground installa-
tions suffered terrific damage.

that our own losses were not

Battle Raged on Leyte

American troops on Leyte
were battling elements of last
Japanese divisions in the hills
north of Ormoc and repulsed
three heavy attacks, including
one on the city. The
city of Ormoc, north of Or-
moc, was under American control
since the 10th Army's capture of
Luzon. (11:4)

Luzon Gains Islanded Ocean Air

Three German bomber attacks
over Luzon were repulsed. The
10th Army Group made im-
portant advances in the North
Philippines and in the North-
west Luzon. (11:4)

Franklin Delano Roosevelt, who
broke more than a century-old tra-
dition in 1936 when he was elected
to a third term as President, today
secured political power primarily
when he was chosen for a fourth
term by a heavy electoral but much
narrower popular majority over
Thomas E. Dewey, Governor of
New York.

At 7:35 A. M. Governor Dewey
announced Mr. Roosevelt's re-
election, ending his best wishes by
radio, in which the President,
quietly responded with an appreci-
ative telegram.


Early this morning Mr. Roose-
velt was making a mounting cam-
paign in thirty-three States with
a total of 261 electoral votes and
with a total vote of 47,000,000
against 40,000,000 for Dewey.
