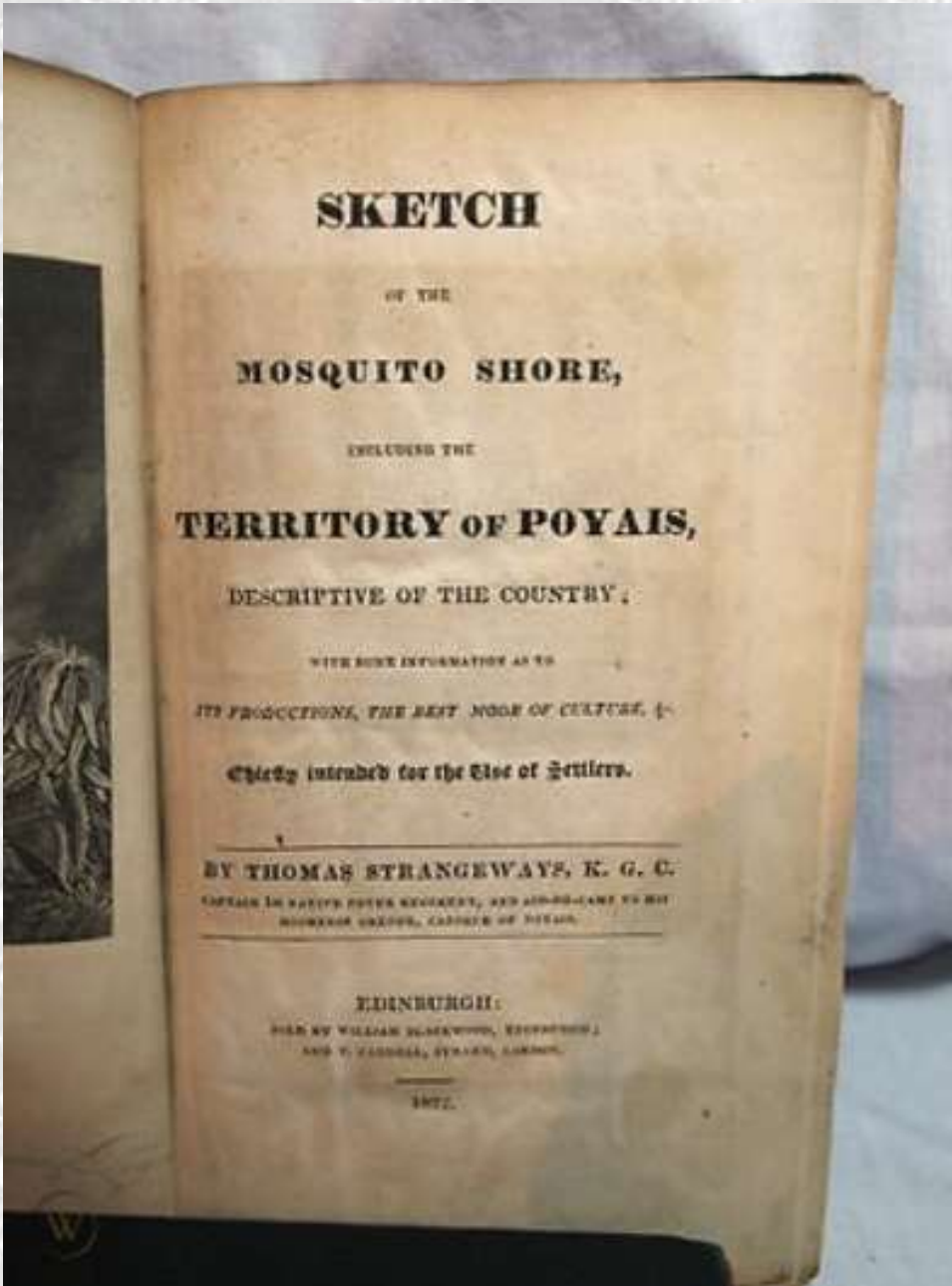

1 Timothy 1:1-7
May 3, 2020

1 Timothy 1:1-7 (ESV): “Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by command of God our Savior and of Christ Jesus our hope, **2** To Timothy, my true child in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. **3** As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, **4** nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith. **5** The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. **6** Certain persons, by swerving from these, have wandered away into vain discussion, **7** desiring to be teachers of the law, without understanding either what they are saying or the things about which they make confident assertions.”



Acts 9:3-5 (ESV): “Now as he went on his way, he approached



Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven shone around him. 4 And falling to the ground, he heard a voice saying to him, ‘Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?’ 5 And he said, ‘Who are you, Lord?’ And he said, ‘I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.’”

Galatians 1:23 (ESV): “He
who used to persecute us is
now preaching the faith he once tried to
destroy.”

2 Timothy 1:5 (ESV): “I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well. **6** For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands.”
