

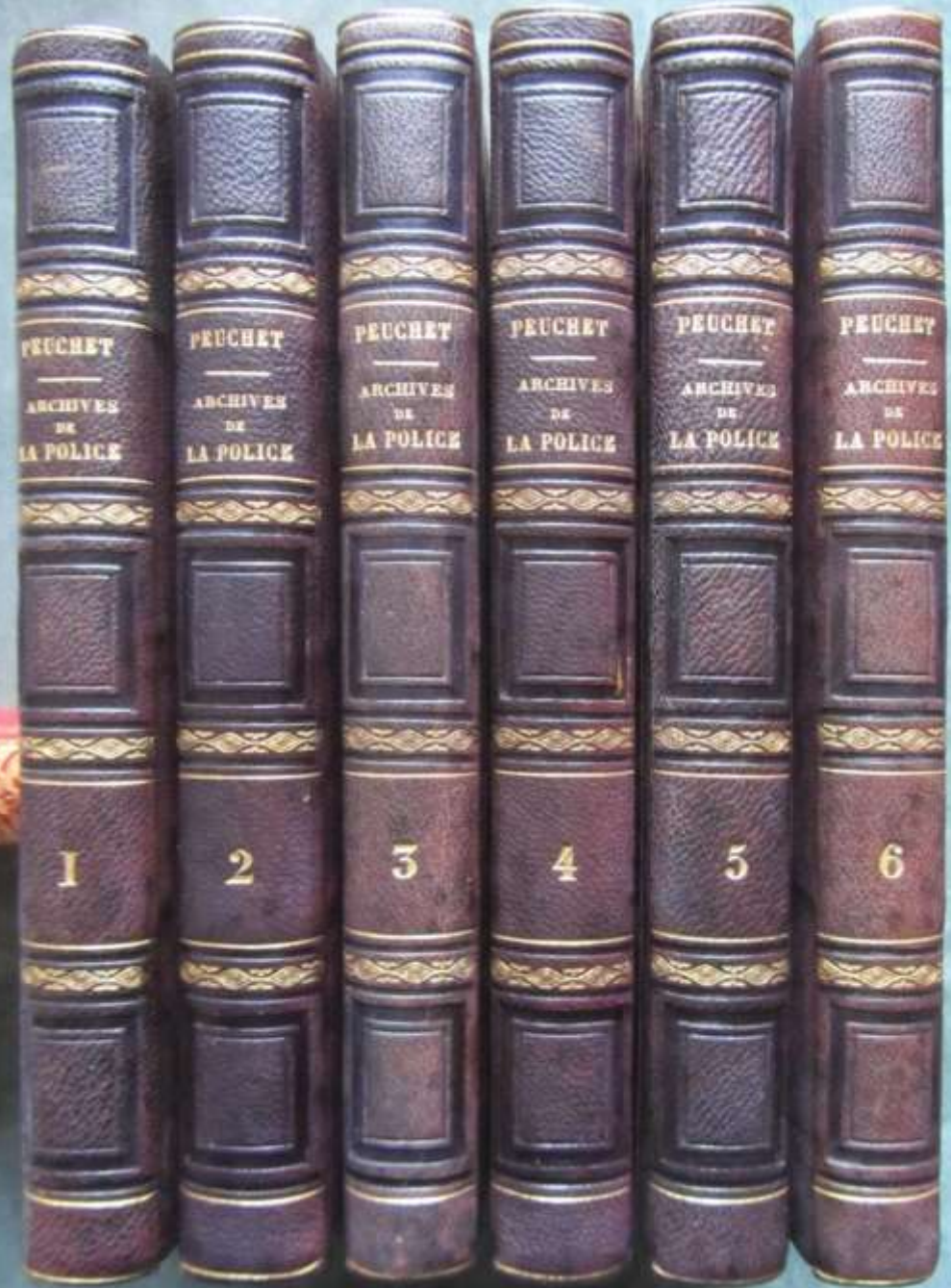

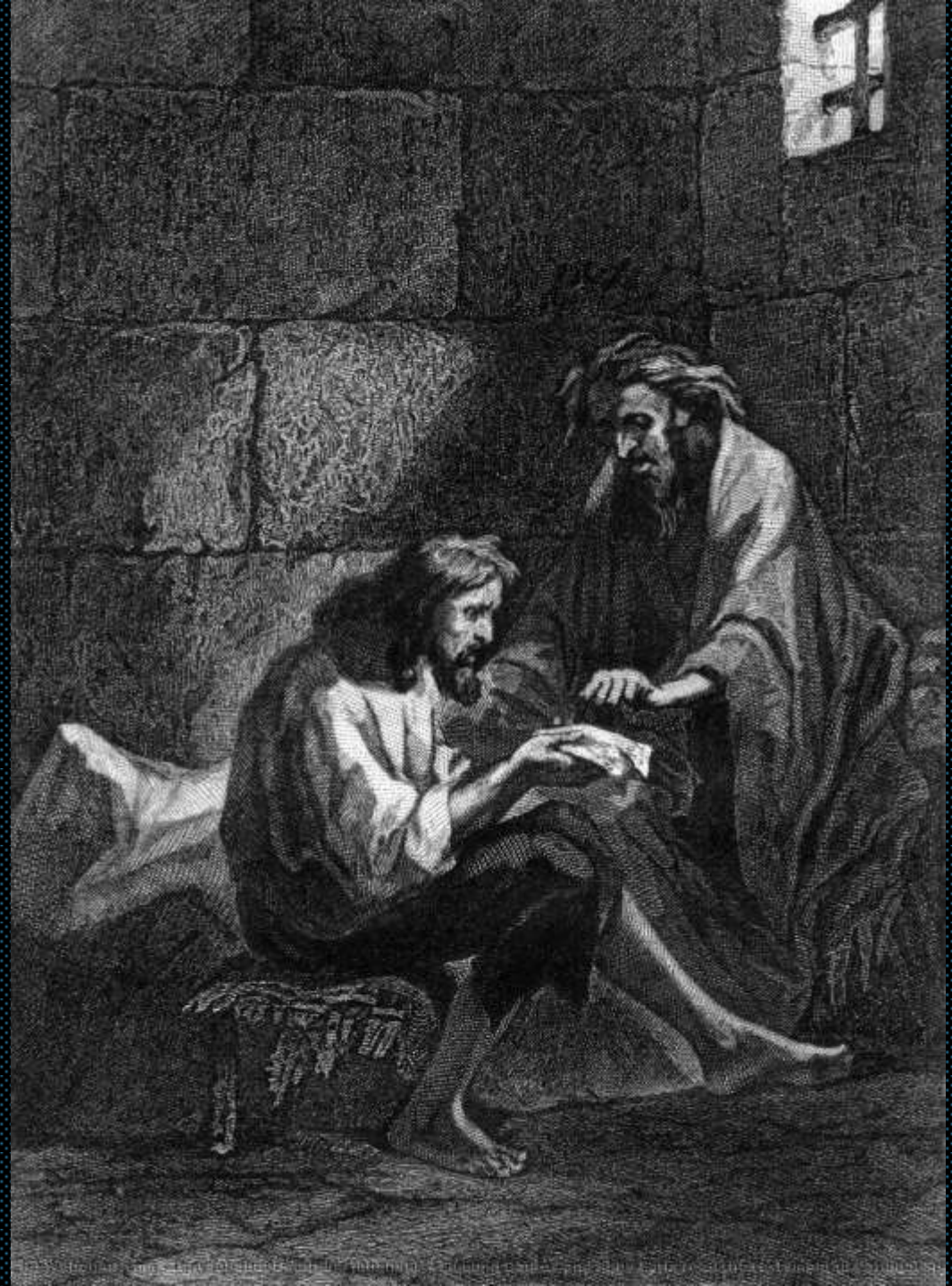

1 Timothy 1:8-20 (ESV): “Now we know that the law is good, if one uses it lawfully, 9 understanding this, that the law is not laid down for the just but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and sinners, for the unholy and profane, for those who strike their fathers and mothers, for murderers 10 the sexually immoral, men who practice homosexuality, enslavers, liars, perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound doctrine,...”

Amen....”

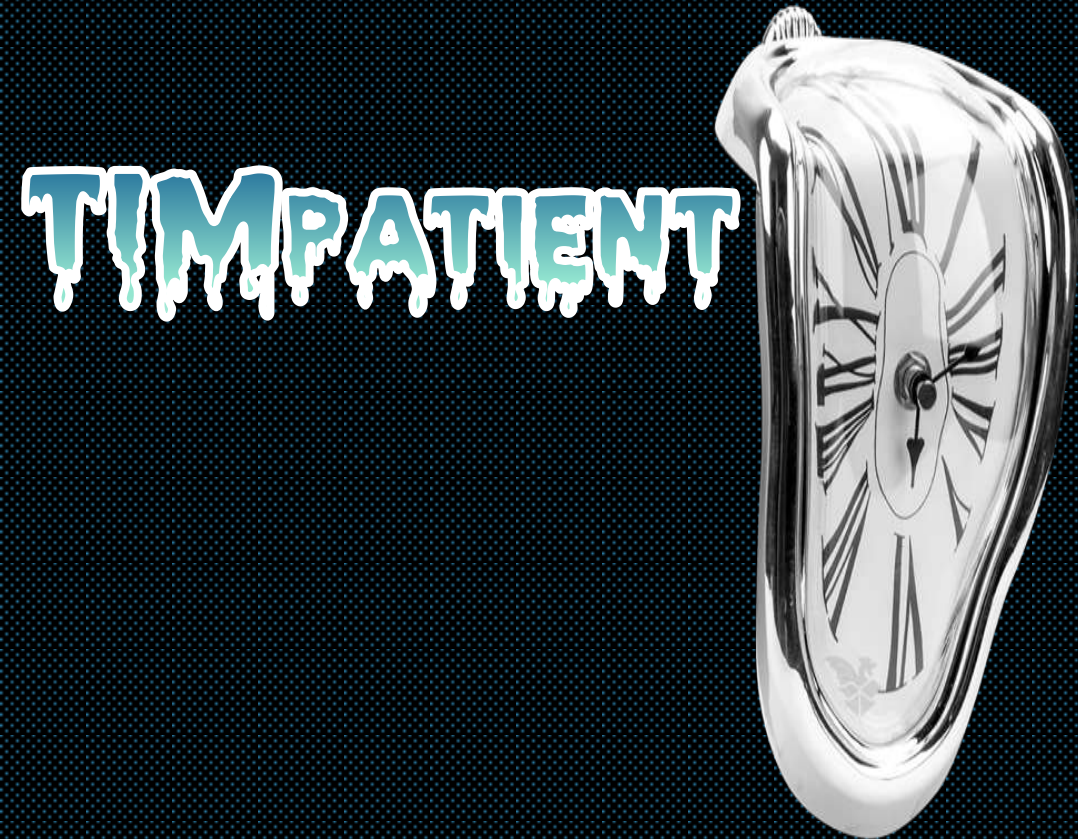

Mark 10:31 (ESV): “But many who are **first** will be last, and the last **first**.”

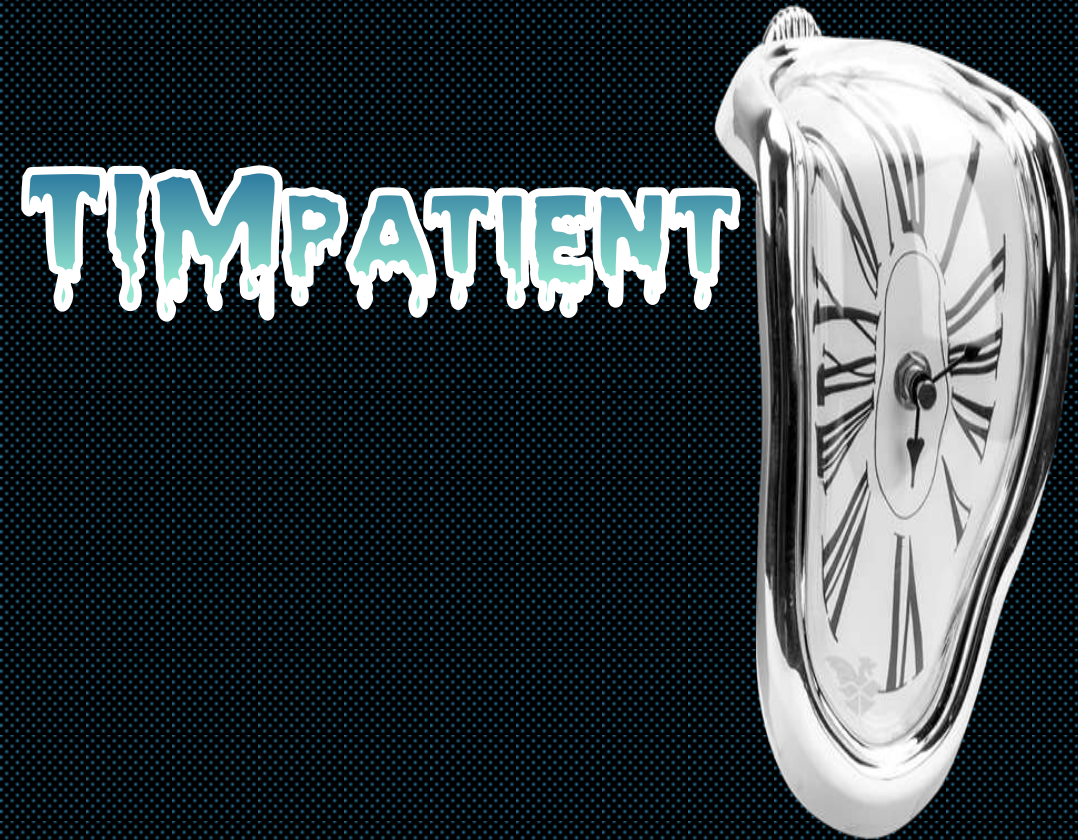

And instantly the woman was made **well.**”

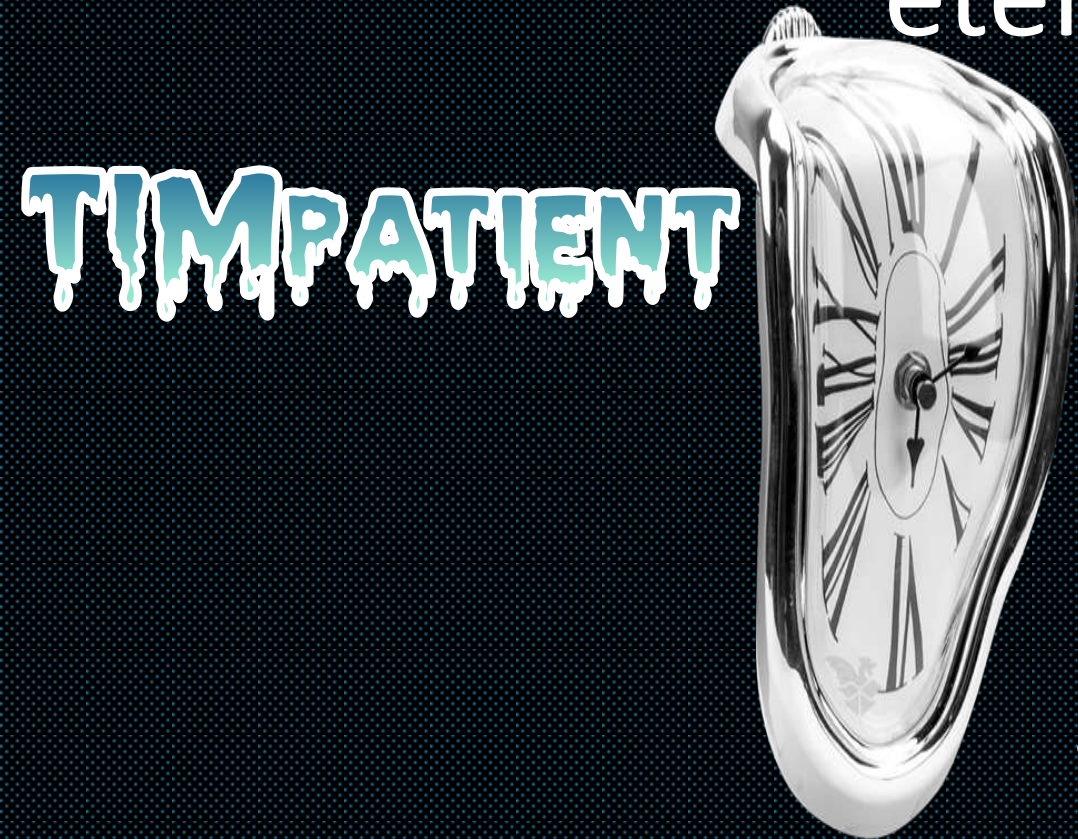


Mark 10:52 (ESV): “Go your way; your faith has made you **well**.’ And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him on the way.”
