


















John 10:11-21 (ESV): "I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me,..."

"...15 just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep. 16 And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd. 17 For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay


down my life that I may take it up again. 18 No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord...."

Galatians 6:2 (ESV): "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ."







John 11:4 (ESV): "It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it."





11 because on account of him many of the Jews were going away and believing in Jesus."






LIVE TO TELL THE TALE.
