















"[F]or there broke out a prodigious storm in the night, with the utmost violence, and very strong winds, with the largest showers of rain, with continued lightnings, terrible thunderings, and amazing concussions and bellowings of the earth, that was in an earthquake....[A]nyone would guess that these wonders foreshowed some grand calamities that were coming." (From Josephus' Wars of the Jews, Book 4, Chapter 4, Paragraph 5)

"Evil omens occurred. A comet was seen, and the moon, contrary to precedent, appeared to suffer two eclipses, being obscured on the fourth and on the seventh day."

(From Cassius Dio's Roman History, Chapter 64)

"The zealots also joined in the shouts...and the storm itself rendered the cry more terrible....[T]hey are naturally a most barbarous and bloody nation....Now there was at present neither any place for flight, nor any hope of preservation; but as they were driven one upon another in heaps, so were they slain....And now the outer temple was all of it overflowed with blood; and that day, as it came on, they saw eight thousand five hundred dead bodies there."

(From Josephus' *Wars of the Jews*, Book 4, Chapter 5, Paragraph 1)

"[I]n the morning there fell a violent wind upon them...and there dashed their ships one against another, and dashed some of them against the rocks....[T]he shore was so rocky, and had so many of the enemy upon it, that they were afraid to come to land....And much lamentation there was when the ships were dashed against one another, and a terrible noise when they were broken to pieces....But some of them thought that to die by their own swords was lighter than by the sea,..."

"...and so they killed themselves before they were drowned; although the greatest part of them were carried by the waves, and dashed to pieces against the abrupt parts of the rocks, insomuch that the sea was bloody a long way, and the maritime parts were full of dead bodies; for the Romans came upon those that were carried to the shore, and destroyed them; and the number of the bodies that were thus thrown out of the sea was four thousand and two hundred." (From Josephus' Wars of the Jews, Book 3, Chapter 10, Paragraph 9)



"[T]he sedition at Jerusalem was revived, and parted into three factions, and that one faction fought against the other....[O]ne should not mistake if he called it a sedition begotten by another sedition, and to be like a wild beast grown mad, which for want of food from abroad, fell now upon eating its own flesh." (From Josephus' *Wars of the Jews*, Book 5, Chapter 1, Paragraphs 1 and 4)

- "She then attempted a most unnatural thing; and snatching up her son, who was a child sucking at her breast, she said, 'O thou miserable infant! For whom shall I preserve thee in this war, this famine, and this sedition? As to the war with the Romans, if they preserve our lives, we must be slaves. This famine also will destroy us, even before that slavery comes upon us. Yet are these seditious rogues more terrible than both the other. Come on; be thou my food."

"They were everywhere slain and everywhere beaten. And as for a great part of the people, they were weak, and without arms, and had their throats cut wherever they were caught. Now round about the altar lay dead bodies, heaped one upon another; as at the steps going up to it, ran a great quantity of their blood: whither also the dead bodies that were slain above [on the altar] fell down....Caesar was no way able to restrain the enthusiastic fury of the soldiers." (From Josephus' *Wars of the Jews*, Book 6, Chapter 4, Paragraphs 6 and 7)

"Now as soon as the army had no more people to slay or to plunder, because there remained none to be the objects of their fury (for they would not have spared any, had there remained any other work to be done), [Titus] gave orders that they should now demolish the entire city and temple....[I]t was so thoroughly laid even with the ground by those that dug it up to the foundation, that there was left nothing to make those that came thither believe it had ever been inhabited." (From Josephus' *Wars of the Jews*, Book 7, Chapter 1, Paragraph 1)

"But the rest of the apostles, who were harassed in innumerable ways, with a view to destroy them, and driven from the land of Judea, had gone forth to preach the gospel to all nations, relying upon the aid of Christ, when he said, 'Go ye, teach all nations in my name.' The whole body, however, of the church at Jerusalem, having been commanded by a divine revelation, given to the men of approved piety there before the war,..."

"...removed from the city, and dwelt at a certain town beyond the Jordan, called Pella. Here, those that believed in Christ, having removed from Jerusalem, as if the holy men had entirely abandoned the royal city itself, and the whole land of Judea. The divine justice, for their crimes against Christ and his apostles, finally overtook them, totally destroying the whole generation of these evildoers from the earth." "...23 Alas for women who are pregnant and for those who are nursing infants in those days! For there will be great distress upon the earth and wrath against this people. 24 They will fall by the edge of the sword and be led captive among all nations, and Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled...." 
