


























2 Samuel 7:15-17 (ESV): "'My steadfast love will not depart from [your son], as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. 16 And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.' 17 In accordance with all these words, and in accordance with all this vision, Nathan spoke to David."


Luke 1:31-33 (ESV): "And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, 33 and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end."

Revelation 22:16-17 (ESV): "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to testify to you about these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.' 17 The Spirit and the Bride say, 'Come.' And let the one who hears say, 'Come.' And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price." CAMP DAVID 1 Samuel 21:1-4 (ESV): "Then David came to Nob, to Ahimelech the priest. And Ahimelech came to meet David, trembling, and said to him, 'Why are you alone, and no one with you?' 2 And David said to Ahimelech the priest, 'The king has charged me with a matter and said to me, "Let no one know anything of the matter about which I send you, and with which I have charged you." I have made an appointment with the young men for such and such a place. 3 Now then, what do you have on hand? Give me five loaves of bread, or whatever is here.' 4 And the priest answered David, 'I have no common bread on hand, but there is holy

bread."

Exodus 29:32-33 (ESV): "And Aaron and his sons shall eat the flesh of the ram and the bread that is in the basket in the entrance of the tent of meeting. 33 They shall eat those things with which atonement was made at their ordination and consecration, but an outsider shall not eat of them, because they are holy. 34 And if any of the flesh for the ordination or of the bread remain until the morning, then you shall burn the remainder with fire. It shall

not be eaten, because it is holy."



1 Samuel 21:10-15 (ESV): "And David rose and fled that day from Saul and went to Achish the king of Gath. 11 And the servants of Achish said to him, 'Is not this David the king of the land? Did they not sing to one another of him in dances, "Saul has struck down his thousands, and David his ten thousands"?' 12 And David took these words to

heart and was much afraid of Achish the king of Gath...."

"...13 So he changed his behavior before them and pretended to be insane in their hands and made marks on the doors of the gate and let his spittle run down his beard. 14 Then Achish said to his servants, 'Behold, you see the man is mad. Why then have you brought him to me? 15 Do I lack madmen, that you have brought this fellow to behave as a madman in my

fellow to behave as a madman in my presence? Shall this fellow come into my house?"









1 Samuel 22:1-5 (ESV): "David departed from there and escaped to the cave of Adullam. And when his brothers and all his father's house heard it, they went down there to him. 2 And everyone who was in distress, and everyone who was in debt, and everyone who was bitter in soul, gathered to him. And he became commander over them.

And there were with him about four hundred men...."

"...3 And David went from there to Mizpeh of Moab. And he said to the king of Moab, 'Please let my father and my mother stay with you, till I know what God will do for me.' 4 And he left them with the king of Moab, and they stayed with him all the time that David was in the stronghold. 5 Then the prophet Gad said to David, 'Do not remain in the stronghold; depart, and go into the land

the stronghold; depart, and go into the land of Judah.' So David departed and went into the forest of Hereth."







1 Samuel 22:7-16 (ESV): "And Saul said to his servants who stood about him, 'Hear now, people of Benjamin; will the son of Jesse give every one of you fields and vineyards, will he make you all commanders of thousands and commanders of hundreds, 8 that all of you have conspired against me? No one discloses to me when my son makes a covenant with the son of Jesse..."




"... None of you is sorry for me or discloses to me that my son has stirred up my servant against me, to lie in wait, as at this day.' 9 Then answered Doeg the Edomite, who stood by the servants of Saul, 'I saw the son of Jesse to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, 10 and he inquired of the LORD for him and gave him provisions and gave him the sword of Goliath the Philistine.'..."



"...11 Then the king sent to summon Ahimelech the priest, the son of Ahitub, and all his father's house, the priests who were at Nob, and all of them came to the king. 12 And Saul said, 'Hear now, son of Ahitub.' And he answered, 'Here I am, my lord.' 13 And Saul said to him, 'Why have you conspired against me, you and the son of Jesse, in that you have given him bread and a sword and have inquired of God for him, so that he has risen against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?'..."

"...14 Then Ahimelech answered the king, 'And who among all your servants is so faithful as David, who is the king's sonin-law, and captain over your bodyguard, and honored in your house? 15 Is today the first time that I have inquired of God for him? No! Let not the king impute anything to his servant or to all the house of my father, for your servant has known nothing of all this, much or little.' 16 And the king said, 'You shall surely die, Ahimelech, you and all your father's house."





Matthew 12:1-8 (ESV): "At that time Jesus went through the grainfields on the Sabbath. His disciples were hungry, and they began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. 2 But when the Pharisees saw it, they said to him, 'Look, your disciples are doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath.' 3 He said to them, 'Have you not read what David did when he was hungry, and those who were with him:..."



"...4 how he entered the house of God and ate the bread of the Presence, which it was not lawful for him to eat nor for those who were with him, but only for the priests? 5 Or have you not read in the Law how on the Sabbath the priests in the temple profane the Sabbath and are guiltless? 6 I tell you, something greater than the temple is here. 7 And if you had known what this means, "I desire mercy, and not

sacrifice," you would not have condemned the guiltless. 8 For the Son of Man is lord of the

Matthew 12:15-21 (ESV): "Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. And many followed him, and he healed them all 16 and ordered them not to make him known. 17 This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah: 18 'Behold, my servant whom I have chosen, my beloved with whom my soul is well pleased...."






