Exodus 32:1-8 (ESV): "When the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people gathered themselves together to Aaron and said to him, 'Up, make us gods who shall go before us. As for this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.' 2 So Aaron said to them, 'Take Moses Shows Us off the rings of gold that are in the ears of your wives, your sons, and your daughters, and bring them to me.'..."

Exodus 32:9-14 (ESV): "And the LORD said to Moses, 'I have seen this people, and behold, it is a stiff-necked people. 10 Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them, in order that I may make a great nation of you.' But Moses implored the LORD his God and said, 'O LORD, why does your wrath burn hot against your people, whom you have brought out of the land of Egypt with great MOSES SHOWS US power and with a mighty hand?..."

"....12 Why should the Egyptians say, "With evil intent did he bring them out, to kill them in the mountains and to consume them from the face of the earth"? Turn from your burning anger and relent from this disaster against your people. 13 Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, your servants, to whom you swore by your own self, and said to them, "I will multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have promised I will give to your offspring, and they shall Moses Shows Us inherit it forever."' 14 And the LORD relented from the disaster that he had spoken of bringing on his people."



Exodus 32:25-28 (ESV): "And when Moses saw that the people had broken loose (for Aaron had let them break loose, to the derision of their enemies), 26 then Moses stood in the gate of the camp and said, 'Who is on the LORD's side? Come to me.' And all the sons of Levi gathered around him. 27 And he said to them, 'Thus says the LORD God of Israel, "Put your sword on your side each of you, and go to and fro from gate to gate throughout the camp, and each of you kill his brother Moses Shows Us and his companion and his neighbor." 28 And the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And that day about three thousand men of the people fell."

Exodus 33:18-23 (ESV): "Moses said, 'Please show me your glory.' 19 And [God] said, 'I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name "The LORD." And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. 20 But,' he said, 'you cannot see my face, for man shall not see me and live.' 21 And the LORD said, 'Behold, there is a place by me where you shall stand on the rock, 22 and while my glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will MOSES SHOWS US cover you with my hand until I have passed by. 23 Then I will take away my hand, and you shall see my back, but my face shall not be seen."





Exodus 34:5-7 (ESV): "The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. 6 The LORD passed before him and proclaimed, 'The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness. 7 keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the MOSES SHOWS US fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generation."



Exodus 34:29-33 (ESV): "As he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God. 30 Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him. 31 But Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the leaders of the congregation returned to him, and Moses talked with them. **32** Afterward all the people of Israel came near, and he commanded them all that the LORD had spoken with him in MOSES SHOWS US Mount Sinai. 33 And when Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face."

2 Corinthians 3:12-18 (ESV): "Since we have such a hope, we are very bold, 13 not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face so that the Israelites might not gaze at the outcome of what was being brought to an end. 14 But their minds were hardened. For to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains Moses Shows Us unlifted, because only through Christ is it taken away...."

"...15 Yes, to this day whenever Moses is read a veil lies over their hearts. 16 But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. 17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. 18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image Moses Shows Us from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit."





Hebrews 3:16-19 (ESV): "For who were those who heard and yet rebelled? Was it not all those who left Egypt led by Moses? 17 And with whom was he provoked for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did he swear that they would not enter his rest, but to those who were Moses Shows Us disobedient? 19 So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief."
