rivers...."REWRITING HISTORY




MAIN POINT

Romans 9:14-16 (ESV): "What shall we say then? Is there injustice on God's part? By no means! 15 For he says to Moses, 'I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion.' 16 So then it depends not on human will or exertion, but on God, who has mercy."

2 Peter 2:7, 9 (ESV): "If [God] rescued righteous Lot....9 then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials."

Hebrews 11:32-34 (ESV): "For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets – 33 who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, 34 quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight." John 11:25 (ESV): "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live."


